Session Context

Biodiversity is declining at an unprecedented rate in human history, significantly eroding nature's resilience. The preservation of nature and biodiversity is now recognized as crucial to climate change mitigation and adaptation.

There are many opportunities to leverage nature as infrastructure, integrate nature-based solutions into infrastructure development. At the session, we will provide a presentation on "nature as infrastructure" – the key theme of our annual flagship report this year. The report examines how nature affects development, and how development (including in infrastructure) can be done more sustainably to safeguard nature.

The presentation will be followed by an in-depth discussion on the potential of nature, delving into strategies for incorporating valuations of nature and ecosystem capital into investment and development decisions.

- Delve into the concept of "nature as infrastructure," exploring how this concept can guide the development of resilient infrastructure projects that can address climate change and its impact on nature.
