

Tajikistan: Dushanbe-Uzbekistan Border Road Improvement Project (Cofinanced with the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development)

General Procurement Notice

This project will improve the 5 km section of the Dushanbe-Uzbekistan border road from the Avicenna Monument to the West Gate in Dushanbe. The Ministry of Transport of Republic of Tajikistan, the executing agency, intends using the proceeds of loans, once and if signed, from the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB) and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) for the project. EBRD will be the lead co-financier and will administer the project on behalf of AIIB. The project, which has a total estimated cost of USD 90 million equivalent, will require the procurement of the following goods, works and services:

- Civil works for rehabilitation and widening of the section 1 of M41 Dushanbe-Uzbekistan border road from the Avicenna roundabout to the West Gate including 3-level traffic interchange at Avicenna roundabout and construction of two 2-level traffic interchanges at key local road crossings;
- Consultancy services to support the client with project implementation and project accounts audit;
- Consultancy services for supervision of above works.

Tendering for the above contracts is expected to begin in the middle of 2016.

Contracts to be financed with the proceeds of the loans from the Banks will be subject to the EBRD's Procurement Policies and Rules and will be open to firms from any country. The proceeds of the Banks' loans will not be used for the purpose of any payment to persons or entities, or for any import of goods, if such payment or import is prohibited by a decision of

the United Nations Security Council taken under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations or under a law of official regulation of the Purchaser's country.
