5. Project Implementation Status

The first year implementation is slightly slower than planned. The IA is working on finalization of the five construction packages totaling about \$30 million. The procurement for hiring of TA consultants has also started and a Request for EoI is expected to be published in July/August. These procurements will be carried out by centralized procurement units which have recently been established by Ministry of Public Works as an additional safeguard for public procurement. Annual Work Plan for 2019 has been approved by World Bank, subsequent to which MoF has yet to approve the budget document (DIPA). A revised procurement plan for 2019 has also been approved
