2. Project Summary and Objectives

The Project will strengthen national health system in Turkey for COVID-19 response by upgrading designated pandemic hospitals in Istanbul and public hospitals across Turkey through procurement of medical equipment. The total project cost is USD 236 million and co-financed by EBRD (USD 153.4 million) and AIIB (USD 82.6 million).

The Project objective is to support the Government of Turkey in strengthening its healthcare emergency response in public hospitals against the COVID-19 pandemic.

5. Project Implementation Update

The overall implementation has been delayed mainly due to COVID-19 surge from Dec 2020 until Oct 2021 (in the peak of 4th surge, about 30,000 confirmed cases per day) and subsequent lockdowns. As of end-April 2022, 9 packages have been awarded and signed as per the revised Procurement Plan. The Procurement Plan is undergoing further revisions as the COVID-19 pandemic situations evolved and the price estimates of the packages has changed. AllB team is yet to receive the revised procurement plan from the EBRD team. The delay in disbursements during the reporting period was related to the approval of 2022 VAT budget by the Presidency Office (PO) of Turkey. The PO approves each Ministry's budget at the beginning of each year, after which the relevant Ministries can proceed with payments. The MoH informed AlIB and EBRD that the approval process has now been completed in the last week of April 2022, and the second disbursement request to AlIB totaling EUR16 million is expected within May 2022.
