2. Project Summary and Objectives

The project has two main objectives - (i) to improve access to 'safely-managed' water supply and sanitation in selected areas of rural Bangladesh; and (ii) to strengthen sector institutional capacity for water and sanitation. The project has six components (a) investments in piped water schemes to support water scarce communities; (b) investments in sanitation and hygiene facilities in priority public locations; (c) strengthening of policies and regulatory framework and capacity building of local institutions; (d) institutional capacity for project implementation and project management; (e) COVID-19 emergency responses by providing quick just-in-time WASH facilities where needed; and (f) Contingent emergency response - provisional zero amount component for reallocation of loan proceeds, if required.

Reporting Period From 2022/07 To 2022/12

The project will be implemented by two implementing agencies Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) and Palli Karma-Sahayak Foundation (PKSF). The implementation period is November 2020 to May 2025.

The total project cost is USD550.5 million which shall be financed AIIB loan of USD200 million, World Bank's IDA loan of USD200 million (lead co-financier) and counterpart funds through Government of Bangladesh of USD150.5 million.

5. Project Implementation Update

Implementation update for DPHE executed part: DPHE has made swift progress with the tendering of various Goods, Works and Services packages. About 40% of the Works contract by value have already been tendered. Physical construction works under Component 5 have been ongoing since Q1FY2022 while works under Component 1 and Component 2 have also started from Q2FY22.

Implementation update for PKSF executed part: All major Services and Goods contracts have been executed. PKSF has been disbursing loans at a field level since January 2022. A total of 3492 Water Supply facilities and 14388 safely managed toilets have been constructed through PKSF loans.

Financial Management:

In both agencies, the financial management consultants are on board. The Officer of the Comptroller and Auditor General of Bangladesh is conducting external project audit of DPHE and is expected to submit report by December 31, 2022.

PKSF has advanced an amount of approximately USD37 million to its Partner Organizations which needs to be further on-lent to individual beneficiaries. Since the counterpart funding needs to be tracked at the beneficiary level, the reporting mechanism is expected to be strengthened to ensure that the counterpart financing ratio (19 percent) for MFI loans is properly reflected in the quarterly reports. The Project's internal audit will be included in the annual plan of PKSF's internal audit department. The hiring process of the external audit is expected to be completed soon and a report will be submitted to the Bank by December 31, 2022.
