LLC., IFC's first subsidiary, and served as its Principal and Investment Committee Member, where she successfully raised capital from global sovereign wealth funds and institutional investors for a USD1 billion Africa and Latin America Fund, as well as contributed to the establishment of AMC's Asia Fund.

With a career spanning more than 30 years, Lim has held a range of senior leadership positions as well as corporate board positions at private companies in emerging markets. She has successfully led multi-cultural teams to execute investment strategies across the consumer services, infrastructure, and financial sectors in Africa,

Asia, Eastern Europe, and Latin America. Lim has an MBA from the University of Maryland and a B. Economics from Flinders University of South Australia. Lim is from Malaysia.
