Rajat Misra is Director General, Public Sector Clients Department (Region 1). He is responsible for managing the Bank's investment operations with public sector clients in South Asia (except Afghanistan and Pakistan), Southeast Asia, the Pacific Islands, and Sub-Saharan Africa. Prior to this position, Misra served several managerial roles at AIIB, including as Acting Chief Investment Officer, Public Sector (Region 1) and Financial Institutions and Funds (Global) Clients; Acting Vice President for Investment Clients Region 1 and Financial Institutions and Funds (Global); and Director General, Infrastructure Investment Department (Region 1). Before joining AIIB in April 2017, Misra spent 18 years at the investment banking arm of the State Bank of India (SBI). He was also Director and Investment Committee member at SBI Group—Department for International Development (DFID) Fund for Infrastructure. Misra started his career as an R&D engineer

at BHEL, a leading power equipment manufacturing company. He holds a postgraduate degree in Business Management from the Xavier School of Management (XLRI), India, and a bachelor's degree in engineering from the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Varanasi, India.
